Ever the optimist, Moore said, "I like our chances."

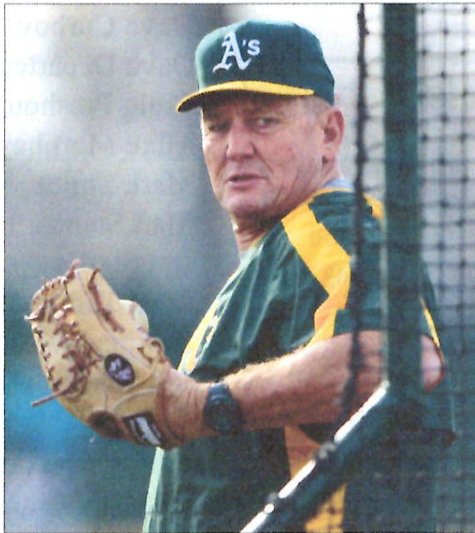
The second Mariners team, managed by Brian Holman and Gary Wheelock will be the "Sons-of-Pitches." Brian explained the
